Although Primary education is free in Uganda, parents have to provide uniforms, books, pens and pencils, etc. for their children. Many families cannot afford this extra expense for the orphans they have taken in, so they cannot go to school.

Our project helps orphans, children suffering with HIV/AIDS or other disability or disadvantage, to complete their Primary School education in Kasese, Kilembe and Rwensande.
